

Articles of Incorporation of New Life Hispanic Ministries

We, the undersigned, residents of the State of Washington hereby subscribe to the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the provisions of Title 24.03, Revised Code of Washington:

ARTICLE I -- NAME

This corporation shall be called New Life Hispanic Ministries.

ARTICLE II -- LOCATION

The address of this corporation is: 1506 W. Lincoln Ave
Yakima, WA 98902

ARTICLE III -- THE PURPOSE

The purpose of New Life Hispanic Ministries shall be to establish churches primarily among Hispanic peoples in the Northwest and to help, encourage and facilitate established churches to witness Christ to the Hispanic community.

ARTICLE IV -- DOCTRINE

This organization believes those doctrines which are consistent with the teachings of the Bible and are expressed in the conservative evangelical tradition. The Statement of Faith of this organization expresses in detail its specific doctrinal beliefs and their Scriptural basis.

ARTICLE V – AMENDMENT PROCEDURE

These articles (except articles IV and VII) may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present at any annual meeting. Amendments must have been submitted in writing to the Board and have been prayerfully considered for a period of not less than ninety (90) days.

ARTICLE VI – POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Separate manuals shall be maintained by the administration for policies and procedures.

Policies shall be established by majority vote of the Board at any meeting. Policy changes shall be enacted by the same procedure. Operating procedures shall be in accordance with the constitution and Board adopted policies. Such procedures shall be established and issued to mission personnel by the executive officer in consultation with the respective field director.

ARTICLE VII – DISSOLUTION

If the Board should consist of less than three (3) persons, or if for other reasons this corporation deems it wise to discontinue, none of its assets shall be divided among its members. After all debts have been satisfied, the remaining members shall transfer all assets to other nonprofit Christian ministries that are in agreement with the beliefs of this organization and have tax exempt status under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VIII – INCORPORATING DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of this corporation is six and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until their successors are elected according to the bylaws are:
